PRAISESTIX™

Visual Expressions of Praise and Worship



On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, took branches of palm trees, and went forth

to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. St. John 12:12-13

PRAISESTIX are a visual expression of our worship. With them we praise and honor our glorious Lord, do spiritual warfare, acknowledge and delight in victory, celebrate His goodness, rejoice in His work and the wonder of who He is. We exalt the name of the Lord and destroy the works of the devil.

There are several uses for PRAISESTIX. They are used in corporate morning worship, praise dances, drill and step teams. They are used to enhance worship, and the anointed use of PRAISESTIX results in a very tangible feeling of the presence of God.

The fabric or “flag” portion of the PRAISESTIX is the primary sign for lifting up a “standard” of God. The Bible refers to the flag as a “standard” or “banner.” It is also used figuratively to define one of God’s names, Jehovah Nissi, the Lord is my banner! God’s salvation and truth is declared by the raising of the banners. *We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the Lord fulfill all thy petitions.* Psalms 20:5

The wooden pole is a staff. It symbolizes the authority given to us by God, to advance His Kingdom, to discern and destroy the powers of darkness. Through using PRAISESTIX, the powers of darkness are defeated, for the Bible declares, *So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.* Isaiah 59:19



Why are PRAISESTIX used in Worship? A Biblical Perspective

- To Bestow Honor ~ to declare a name and an aspect of God's character. As we wave the PRAISESTIX we minister in love to our King and proclaim the magnificence of Who He is.
- To Signal God's presence ~ Lifting flags in worship follows the action of Moses as he lifted his rod (a shepherd's staff, a spiritual type or symbol of a flag) as a visible sign of God's presence, power and authority over the armies of Israel.
- To Direct Warfare and Praise ~ Early records show that in ancient Egyptians battles, soldiers looked to flags (ribbons or fabric tied to poles) to determine the direction of the wind, then shot their arrows accordingly to reach their target. In terms of spiritual warfare, a flag might be waved to say in the physical realm what is happening in the spiritual: it relates the direction of the "wind" of the Holy Spirit, and the enemy is put to flight.

Simply put, PRAISESTIX are a visual expression of our worship. They are a visual reminder of God faithfulness

and His truth. They create an environment of worship where we can enter the presence of God where He wants us to be and we can know the power and authority He has given us through worship.
